

Helpful Hints for Creating Beautiful Purple Heart Plants from Cuttings



HINT 1:

Take your stem cutting just below a node. The plant cells associated with growth are concentrated at the nodes. This location gives you the best chance to grow healthy roots quickly.



HINT 2:

Your cuttings will form roots more quickly if they are kept in a warm, humid environment.

You don't need to place your cuttings into water to form roots. You can place Purple Heart cuttings directly into the soil to propagate. Just be sure to keep the soil moist.



HINT 3:

Once your stems start growing roots, plant them into soil. Although rooted stems can grow in water for a short period of time, you're plants prefer to grow in soil. The sooner you plant your rooted stems, the sooner you will have big, healthy plants.
